

Setting up POP3 Mailbox on iPhone

To configure email accounts on an iPhone (version 1.0 and above) please follow these simple step-by-step instructions.

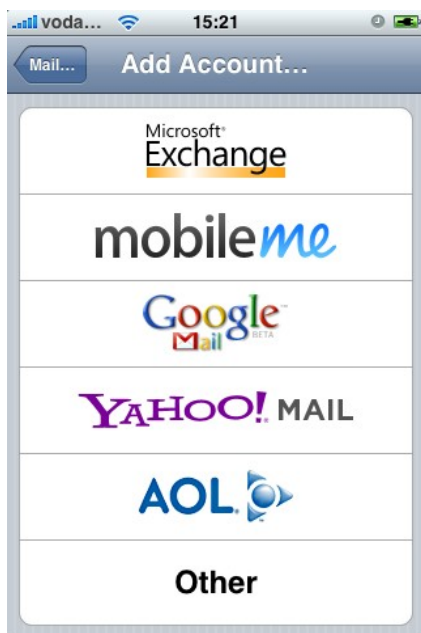
Step 1

Go to the 'settings' and select the option for 'Mail, Contacts, Calendars'

Under 'Accounts' select 'Add Account'

Step 2

From the 'Add Account' option select 'Other'




Step 3

Enter the details for:

Name: (This is how you would like email recipients to see your name eg John Smith or Support)

Address: (This is your full email address eg john@domain.com)

Password: (This is your mailbox password)



Step 5

If you get asked to connect without SSL select 'Yes'. The account settings will be verified and if successful the account details will be stored and your account listed on the following screen.

Step 6 - Finish
